Call To Order: The meeting was called to order by Mary Dankowski, Chair at 6:01 p.m.

Holiday Hoopla - Sebastian , Al- Naemy, and Ludwig will chair this event , which will be held on December 11th at the DPPL. from 1-3 - Interested families will need to register through the DPPL.
